Yet while the public debate about policy responses to these developments continues unabated, research findings of economists are often ignored. Topics covered include the migration decision, the integration of immigrants into the labor market and society, their economic behavior, empirical and theoretical contributions to migration policy, and the effects of immigrants on the native population.
