

## SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

(1) Only discussion papers of fellows, affiliates and IZA staff will be accepted.

(2) The paper should fit into IZA's research program. The current program includes the following seven areas of research:

1. Evaluation of Market Programs
2. Behavioral and Personnel Economics
3. Migration
4. Labor Markets and Institutions
5. Labor Markets in Emerging and Transition Economies
6. The Future of Labor
7. Employment and Development

(3) Many of you may wish to publish your research in another working paper series such as that issued by your home department or another institution to which you are affiliated. We are confident that circulation through the IZA series complements this. We expect that your work will achieve wider circulation as an IZA Discussion Paper, especially on the international level. Therefore, we place no restrictions on submitting your paper simultaneously to working paper series other than ours.

Please note, however, that your paper has to be unpublished research work.

(4) If the dataset you have used for your paper is available on the web, please include the relevant links with your submission so that we can add it to the downloadable version of your paper.

(5) IZA Discussion Papers are no longer available in print. However, we send out electronic versions by e-mail, or printouts by regular mail, to all interested readers who are not able to download the paper from the web. This service is free of charge.

Our papers are also available via RePEc (<http://repec.org>), and they are distributed to a large subscriber base via SSRN (<http://www.ssrn.com>).

(6) Please refrain from submitting largely unfinished work because we do not update or replace the online versions of our papers except in cases where a convincing argument can be made that the original version is seriously flawed.

- Abstract (250 words max.!) )
- Keywords
- JEL Classification
- Complete contact information for the corresponding author

(Note that we provide contact details for one author only, which will usually be the submitting author – unless you inform us otherwise.)

We accept files in PDF or DOC format only.

**IMPORTANT:** Since we produce our own abstract page, please make sure that the body of your paper starts on a separate page.

- ✓ DOES THE INTRODUCTION START ON A SEPARATE PAGE?
- ✓ DID I INCLUDE ABSTRACT, KEYWORDS AND JEL CODES?
